Tutoring and Homework Help

Do you have one hour a week to tutor a child? SPC has an opportunity to do one-on-one tutoring and homework help with students at Apollo Elementary School in Des Plaines. The student body is 17% white, 34% Asian, 28% Hispanic, 7% black, and 15% mixed. 64% of the students are low-income. 56% come from non-English speaking homes. 3% are homeless. Volunteers would need to commit to one hour a week after school, from 2:30 to 3:30 pm. There would be three seasons of tutoring: Fall (mid-September through Thanksgiving), Winter (January through spring break), and Spring (spring break to the end of the school year). Seeking Resurrection Romans 6:3-7 Romans 6:11-14

DIGGING DEEPER

- 1. How did you see/hear/feel the work of God during this baptism Sunday?
- 2. Why do Christians perform and engage in baptism?
- 3. What is your experience with baptism?
