SERMON NOTES

Forsaking Our Comfort 1 Corinthians 9:19 – 23

Introduction: Personally reaching unbelievers for Christ creates challenges for believers.

One: Freedom Yet a Slave

vs. 19

cf. Philippians 2:5 - 8

Two: Being Myself Yet Like Others vs. 20 – 22a

cf. Romans 10:14

Three: My Own Sake or the Sake of the Gospel

vs. 22b, 23

cf. 2 Corinthians 5:15 - 20

Conclusion: The blessings of participating in the gospel mission far outweigh the challenges.
