Unity in Christ - John 17:20 - 26

Introduction: Christians should pursue unity as a key characteristic of transformation.

Three aspects of Christian unity:

One: The Experience of Unity vs. 20 - 23

cf. Ephesians 4:1 - 3

Two: The Impact of Unity vs. 21, 23

Three: The Root of Unity vs. 24 - 26

cf. Ephesians 4:4-6

Conclusion: Christian unity is a manifestation of Christ's glory to the world!

cf. 2 Corinthians 3:18

- 2. How do you see the sharing of Christ's glory as instrumental in our experience of unity?
- 3. How is Christian unity a powerful evidence of the truth of the gospel?
- 4. In what ways does your relationship with Christ affect your relationship with other believers, and vice versa?
- 5. How might your prayers for unity better reflect the concerns of Jesus in this passage?
